SVE COMMITTEE !! - DV AWARENESS MONTH (FACTS+ FIGURES)

- Sexual violence is common even before coming to Rutgers University-New Brunswick
- Graduate students experience sexual and dating violence and **are less aware of resources than undergraduates**
- Approximately **50% of students reported at least one experience of dating violence** since coming to campus
- Rates of sexual violence and dating violence are **higher among queer-spectrum students** than heterosexual students
- Regardless of the gender/sexual orientation of the victim, those who committed these acts of violence tend to be men
- Racial/ethnic minorities are less likely than white students to **disclose an incident of IPV** Source: iSpeak 2018 Results
